Burlington Soccer Club is offering an opportunity for Recreation Soccer Coaches to coach at the Challenge level. If your recreation soccer team is looking for a higher level of competition and you are interested in coaching at the Challenge level, please contact David Myers (david@bscsoccer.net).

What is Challenge Soccer?

Challenge: For U10 through U18 age groups. Program is designed to offer a higher level of competition compared to a recreation program. This is the next step up from recreation. Challenge teams will play other Club Challenge teams that are members of the Triad Challenge League. Half the games are played at home in Burlington at either Joe Davidson or Springwood Parks. The other half are played at the various clubs associated within the Triad Challenge League. Generally games are within an hour or less drive from Burlington.

What can BSC provide to coaches?

Burlington Soccer Club will provide opportunities for coaches to be trained and become certified through United States Soccer Federation coaching courses. Coaching a BSC Challenge team allows for many more playing opportunities, through sanctioned tournaments, that does not exist in most recreation programs. Most importantly, the players will be placed in a more competitive environment that will increase the development of the players.

What are the next steps?

Interested coaches need to contact David Myers (david@bscsoccer.net). Interested players will need to attend the BSC open tryouts and be evaluated by BSC staff members. Once teams are selected from tryouts, Challenge teams will have a coach assigned.
