



Burlington Soccer Club Programs

Burlington Soccer Club (BSC) offers programs for players of all levels that are looking for a competitive environment that is above traditional recreation soccer programs. BSC offers three programs to meet the needs of youth soccer players.

U10 Academy: The Academy Program focuses on development and training that promotes individual player development. Limited space is available and is designed for players that are more advanced for their age compared to their peers. Those not selected to the Academy program are automatically considered for the U10 Challenge program. BSC's academy program is directed by Elon University Women's Head Coach Chris Neal.

Challenge: For U10 through U18 age groups. Program is designed to offer a higher level of training and competition compared to recreation program. This is the next step up from recreation. Challenge teams will play other Club Challenge teams that are members of the Triad Challenge League. Half the games are played at home in Burlington at either Joe Davidson or Springwood Parks. The other half are played at the various clubs associated within the Triad Challenge League. Generally games are within an hour or less drive from Burlington.

Classic: For U11 through U18 age groups. Program is designed to offer the highest level of competition in the state of North Carolina. Within Classic there are different divisions; Premier (highest level), Division I and Division II. Teams generally train 2-3 times a week and play games in Burlington and throughout the State, along with attending various tournaments.
